Authors always write for a reason.

Some of the reasons are:

- to explain something
- to describe something
- to persuade you
- to entertain you.

Authors write to describe.	They use colorful, rich details to tell about people, places and things.
Authors write to persuade.	They try to make readers do something, believe something, or buy something, often by giving opinions.
Authors write to entertain.	They tell stories, using words and ideas that the readers will enjoy
Authors write to <b>explain</b> .	They use facts and details that help readers understand a subject. Sometime they tell you "how to" do something.
